

The Mighty Oaks Foundation is committed to serving Warriors in need around the globe through intensive peer-based discipleship programs, outpost meetings, speaking, and resiliency events. We have programs for Men, Women, and Married Couples at multiple locations nationwide and globally. Those who attend our programs are fully sponsored, to include meals, lodging and travel, ensuring their sole focus is on resiliency, recovery and identifying purpose as they move forward.





Our intensive peer-to-peer based programs serve as the catalyst to assist warriors in critical need around the world, in discovering the answers to the big questions in life, dealing with challenges related to the struggles of their service, combat deployments, and the symptoms of post-traumatic stress (PTS). Our programs are available at **NO COST** to service men & women and are held at beautiful locations across the U.S. and internationally.







## RESILIENCY EVENTS

The United States Military is the most equipped fighting force in the world in terms of manpower and equipment. These brave men and women have provided a blanket of freedom for America, and other nations of the world, where we answered the call to fight for those who could not protect themselves. However, at times that freedom comes at a cost resulting in combat stress or Post Traumatic Stress, Veteran suicide, and the divorce of our military families. Mighty Oaks has reached over 400,000 through our Resiliency events and we have handed out over 250,000 books to help our Nation's Warriors and those Warriors around the world.

## **ADVOCACY**



### CASE STATEMENT

#### THE CHALLENGE

According to the Department of Veteran Affairs, every day in America, over twenty veterans commit suicide. The V.A. Hotline receives an average of 400 calls per day. We've recently hit the highest military active duty suicide rate in years. At the same time, the divorce rate among active military personnel and returning Veterans is staggering, impacting Veterans, as well as their families. Many combat vets are unable to reintegrate back into civilian life leaving their families to work through the aftermath.

#### THE SOLUTION

Our purpose is to heal the brokenhearted by addressing the spiritual injury of combat trauma and to reverse its effects in these families that have already sacrificed so much for our nation. After more than 5,000 alumni to our programs, we have one of the highest success rates for any program in preventing veteran suicide and divorce. In fact, our programs are so successful that we receive hundreds of active duty military on official orders.

#### **OUR PROGRAMS**

Through instructional sessions, camaraderie, and team building activities, our programs teach Warriors to overcome their past experiences and move forward into a life of purpose. However, our recovery programs don't end with the program itself, what sets Mighty Oaks apart is our Aftercare Program, continued engagement and the support network we provide. We have grown our Aftercare to over 40 outpost locations nationwide. Additionally, we've reached over 500,000 active duty through our Military Resiliency events and have handed out numerous books & free resources, amplifying our message and exponentially growing the numbers we are able to extend a lifeline to.




